RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the responsibility of nominating and selecting roads to be included in the BIA Road System; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that McNary town roads, Hondah Homesite roads, and Theodore Roosevelt School roads should be placed on the BIA Road System.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby places on the BIA Road System the community roads in the town of McNary, Hondah Homesites, and the Theodore Roosevelt School.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 5, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
