

**RESOLUTION OF THE

**WHEREAS,** Land Office Director, Raymus Albert has come before the Tribal Council requesting approval of land board meeting minutes of December 6, 1996; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council has reviewed the land board meeting minutes and is in agreement that the minutes should be for granting Bradley Clarkson approval for a homesite only, pending a review by the Land Office.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the land board meeting minutes of December 6, 1996, correcting minutes to reflect that Bradley Clarkson's approval should be for a homesite only, pending further review by the Land Office.

The foregoing resolution was on February 06, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (h), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
