- WHEREAS, after reading the briefs to the Tribal Council, the Tribal Council concludes that the briefs for February 5, 1997, item number 3, be corrected to include that Councilmember Herbert Tate did request that the Theodore Roosevelt School Board conduct a background investigation on Mr. Ben Chavez; and
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Alvin Declay also requested that item number 14, be corrected to identify the following communities who will benefit from the donation of funds received from Navajo County: Hondah for a playground, Cibecue for concrete for a basketball court and Seven Mile for a playground; and
- WHEREAS, Tribal Council further concludes that briefs for February 6, 1997 and special walkthru resolutions briefs for February, 1997 be approved as presented.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Council meeting briefs for February 5, 1997 with correction to item number 3, where Councilmember Herbert Tate did request that the Theodore Roosevelt School Board conduct a background investigation on Mr. Ben Chavez.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that Councilmember Alvin Declay requested that briefs for February 5, 1997 also be corrected on item number 14 to identify communities who will benefit from the donation of funds from Navajo County: Hondah for a playground, Cibecue for concrete for a basketball court and Seven Mile for a playground.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that briefs for February 6, 1997 and special walk-thru resolution briefs for February, 1997 be approved as presented.
