## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Council Member Margaret Walker has updated the Tribal Council on HUD meetings regarding the Rulemaking Negotiation Committee and advises the Council that there is a need for the White Mountain Apache Tribe to be recognized and heard on the committee; and
- WHEREAS, after discussion, the Tribal Council agrees that the White Mountain Apache Tribe should request that it be designated as an alternate for the San Carlos Apache Tribe in future Rulemaking Negotiation Committee meetings.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests that the HUD Rulemaking Negotiation Committee designate the White Mountain Apache Tribe as an alternate for the San Carlos Apache Tribe for future Rulemaking Negotiation Committee meetings.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>March 14, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
