RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member Michael Endfield received approval from the Tribal Council for a 25 year homesite lease for Hondah Homesite Lot A-27 by Resolution No. 05-93-101; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-93-101 did not authorize Michael Endfield to encumber the leased premises for the purpose of securing financing nor did it specify that the lease would provide for an automatic 25 year renewal.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants permission to Michael Endfield to encumber the leased premises described in Resolution No. 05-93-101 for the purpose of securing a loan through the Revolving Credit Program or the HUD 184 Program only, such financing to be arranged solely at Mr. Endfield's expense.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that said lease shall provide for a 25 year lease term with an automatic 25 year renewal.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 03, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of six for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (g), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
