## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council during a special session this date has reviewed in depth proposed revisions to the Tribal Election Code; and
- WHEREAS, said Code had been previously posted for public comment and the Tribal Council has again reviewed the Election Code and made further changes, all of which are reflected in the attached proposed Election Code Revision, incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is satisfied that the attached proposed Election Code meets the requirements of the Tribal Constitution and will otherwise clarify election matters for candidates and voters and should be posted in accordance with the Tribal Constitution for further public comment.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to repost the proposed Election Code attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein as required by the Tribal Constitution for a minimum of ten days prior to final action by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 7, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribe Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (q), (s), (t) and (u) and Article VI, Section 8 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
