

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. Modesto Dunlap and Mrs. Susie (Wool) Dunlap are requesting enrollment for their adopted daughter with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Mary Maria Dunlap's enrollment application whose birth date is December 22, 1990 with supporting documents; and

WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds Mary Maria Dunlap, is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of ½ White Mountain Apache and ½ total Indian Blood according to the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. & Mrs. Modesto Dunlap's request for enrollment of their adopted daughter Mary Maria Dunlap's membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, and subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202 © and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on April 11, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article II, Sections 1 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
