

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** tribal member Juan Antonio, has come before the Tribal Council with a request that he is in dire need of housing improvements; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that good cause exists to place Mr. Antonio on the HIP priority list.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs that tribal member Juan Antonio be placed on the HIP priority list..

The foregoing resolution was on May 14, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (i) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
