RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has previously discussed with the Bureau of Indian Affairs the necessity for an airport in the Cibecue community for the purposes of providing greater access by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to fulfill Bureau responsibilities as well as providing ready access for emergency medical services to the area; and
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has prepared a legal description for the proposed Cibecue Airport Compound on Resolution No. 07-93-202 comprised of approximately 130. 427 acres, but the correct acres should be 163.41 acres, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated by reference herein; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to reserve said land for use as the Cibecue Airport Compound pending discussions with livestock associations and the Land Board.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby recinds Resolution No. 07-93-202 and changes the total acres to 163.41 for the Cibecue Airport Compound Project in accordance with the legal description attached to this resolution and incorporated by reference herein.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that a formal assignment of said land for the Cibecue Airport Compound shall be subject to consultation with livestock associations and the Land Board to determine the impact on both.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (b), (e), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
