## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS the Tribal Council has previously discussed with the Bureau of Indian Affairs the necessity for an airport in the Cibecue community to provide greater access for the Bureau of Indian Affairs to fulfill Bureau responsibilities as well as providing ready access for emergency medical services to the area; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed Cibecue Airport would need a right-of-way, as identified in the attached map, consisting of 163.41 acres; and
- WHEREAS, tribal member Carrie Narcisco Gooday has a farmland assignment within the proposed right-of-way; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Gooday has agreed to exchange her farmland assignment within the right-of-way for a farmland assignment of approximately 2.47 irrigated acres identified on the attached map; and
- WHEREAS, the Livestock Association and Land Board have approved the land transfer for Ms. Gooday; and
- WHEREAS, after due consideration and recommendation, the Tribal Council concludes that permission should be granted to tribal member Carrie Narcisco Gooday for the irrigated farmland in exchange for the surrender of her farmland assignment within the proposed right-of-way of the Cibecue Airport.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves an assignment of farmland to tribal member Carrie Narcisco Gooday in an amount of approximately 2.47 acres, as shown on the attached map, in exchange for the surrender of her land assignment and any other right, title or interest to the farmland located within the proposed Cibecue Airport right-of-way.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (b), (e), (f), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
