RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Danny Sedillo, Director of the Tribal Employment Rights Office and Tribal Apprenticeship Program had requested that the Tribal Council appoint the Tribal Apprenticeship Committee [TAP], which is required so that the White Mountain Apache Tribe TERO Office and TAP meet the requirements of the Department of Labor [Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training] as the TERO/TAP Program is registered under the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training; and

WHEREAS, the following individuals are recommended to be appointed as the TAP Committee:

- 1. Cline Greggs Tribal Member employed by the Tribe at the Skill Center
- 2. Brenda Gloshay Tribal Member employed by the Tribe at JTPA
- 3. Kenneth Westover Married to a Tribal Member employed by the Tribe at Hon Dah Casino; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing individuals have agreed to serve the White Mountain Apache Tribe TAP Committee if they are approved by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs in the recommendation from the TERO Director.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Cline Greggs, Brenda Gloshay and Kenneth Westover as the White Mountain Apache Tribe - Tribal Apprenticeship Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that said appointment shall supersede any previous TAP Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
