## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, on April 7, 1997, directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed Election Code in each district for ten days, as required by the Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, the Council Secretary has advised the Tribal Council that said proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received no opposition to the proposed amended Election Code and concludes that Ordinance No. 208, which establishes the Election Code and deletes Chapter Three, Elections, from the Government Code, should be enacted into law.
  - **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 208, establishing the Election Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of five for and two against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections / (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
