RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to provide financial assistance to Tribal Members, Latoya Beatty to attend a summer session at Exeter Preparatory School, Nelson Lupe III to attend the Junior Nationals U.S. Eastern Regional Championship finals, and Belinda Colelay to attend Project Phoenix at Augsburg College in Minneapolis, MN; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that each student should be provided Three Hundred (\$300) dollars financial assistance to help defray travel expenses and that said assistance be paid from the Tribal Chairman's Public Relations Account.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Three Hundred (\$300) dollars each in travel assistance funds from the Tribal Chairman's Public Relations Fund for Latoya Beatty, Nelson Lupe III, and Belinda Colelay.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it wishes Latoya Beatty, Nelson Lupe III and Belinda Colelay a safe and successful trip as they pursue their personal goals.

The foregoing resolution was on May 23, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (i), (k) (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
