

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe previously adopted resolution No. 10-96-249, approving the action of the Tribe entering into a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation for the purpose of securing federal funds and technical assistance to undertake community surveying and mapping projects; and

**WHEREAS,** surveying and mapping of the Cedar Creek Community was completed during Winter 1996-97 under a draft cooperative agreement, the product of which can now be used to build accurate maps of water and sewer, to undertake community development planning, to perform floodplain analyses, and to serve a variety of other uses; and

**WHEREAS,** the draft cooperative agreement has been revised and has undergone Legal and Tribal Planning Department review, and would allow for assistance to be provided to the Tribe from the Bureau of Reclamation under its Indian program authorities, with job task orders written for individual projects which arise and are desired by the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** tribal member training and the protection of sensitive information will remain top priorities of the Tribal Council through any and all work relationships entered into through benefit of this cooperative agreement.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to enter into a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Reclamation, for purposes of conducting community surveying and mapping projects, for training of tribal members in surveying and other technical disciplines, and for other projects within the Bureau's Indian program authorities, to be determined at a later date by the Tribal Council.

**Resolution No. 06-97-160**

The foregoing resolution was on June 11, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
