

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Brian Declay has come before the Tribal Council to ask that he be given permission to receive water hookup from the Indian Health Service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council has concluded that the restrictions set in place for Hondah Homesites Sections A and B in Resolution 08-96-189 should not be applied retroactively to Mr. Declay's request which was submitted prior to the effective date of the restrictions; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Declay's homesite is not within the boundaries of Hondah Homesites Section A or B.


**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. Brian Declay's request to have permission from the Tribe to allow IHS to provide water hookup services to Mr. Declay's residence at Hondah.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
