## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Agency has presented for Tribal Council approval the Bureau of Indian Affairs FY 1999 budget as attached hereto; and
- WHEREAS, after considerable discussion the Tribal Council agrees with the recommendation of Administrative Officer Ivan Kitcheyan that \$108,000 be moved to Agriculture so that the funding amount is \$133,000 and that funds be transferred from BIA to the Realty Specialist position and office to bring that budget to \$50,000; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council concurs in the foregoing recommendations and amendments to the budget attached hereto.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the FY 1999 Bureau of Indian Affairs budget for the Fort Apache Agency as attached hereto and as amended with the transfer of funds to agriculture and to the Realty Specialist position and office.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 26, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (c), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
