## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to grant a request submitted by petition from District III Committee Members to utilize \$2,000 in General Land Claims Fund to take fourteen (14) students and four (4) chaperones to the Unity Conference in Phoenix, Arizona on June 27, 1997; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is satisfied that the petition represents the desire of the District III Community to utilize General Land Claims Funds for that purpose.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the District III Community petition to utilize \$2,000 in General Land Claims Funds for the purpose of taking fourteen (14) students and four (4) chaperones to the Unity Conference in Phoenix on June 27, 1997.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>June 26, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
