

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS**, Tribal Member Lucy Benally has come before the Tribal Council this date with the request that she be granted a homesite for a vacant lot number A-80 in Hondah Homesites; and

**WHEREAS** Hondah Homesite assignments are being made by the Tribal Council; and


**WHEREAS**, Ms. Benally requests Lot A-79 adjacent to Lot A-80 because Lot A-79 and A-80 are smaller than the traditional Homesite lot size of 200 feet by 200 feet; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tribal Council explains to Ms. Benally that Ramus Albert of the Tribal Land Office has been directed to resurvey Hondah Homesite lots so that they will approach the 200 x 200 foot traditional size, granted by the Tribal Council. But until the survey is completed she is advised to accept Lot A-80 only and that she can renew her request for Lot A-79 or part of Lot A-79 when the Tribal Land Office has completed its survey and Ms. Benally expresses her agreement with this recommendation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants a homesite assignment to vacant Lot A-80 in Hondah Homesites to Tribal Member Lucy Benally.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it directs the Tribal Council Secretary to send a copy of this resolution to the Tribal Land Office for their records.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (m), (n), (q), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
