RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member, Ludy Altaha has come before the Tribal Council this date with a request for a donation from the Tribal Council to assist in travel expenses for her son Jerold Altaha to travel to Washington, D.C. as a S.A.D.D. representative for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is agreeable to donating \$300 to Jerold Altaha for that purpose as explained in more detail in the attached letter of request from Betty L. Sanchez.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$300 from the Tribal Chairman Public Relations Account to assist Jerold Altaha in his travel expenses to Washington, D.C. where he will attend a S.A.D.D. conference as a representative of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 10, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
