- WHEREAS, the Diamond Creek Rockies comprised of Tribal Members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe have won the White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Championship Game for the last three (3) years; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested to approve expenditure of \$504.29 in General Land Claims funds for the District IV team; and
- WHEREAS, in recognition of the Regional Baseball Champs, the Diamond Creek Rockies, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs in the request.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby extends its congratulations to the Diamond Creek Rockies for being the Regional Baseball Champions of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Regional Championship Game.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that it hereby appropriates \$504.29 from the General Land Claims Funds [District IV] for the purchase of medals and pullovers for the Diamond Creek Rockies Championship Team outlined in the attached request for funding dated July 9, 1997 from Leo Walker, Sr., Coach, and Ronald Massey, Sr., Assistant Coach.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>July 10, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
