RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is requested that it approve expenditure of \$250 from the General Land Claims Fund for the Rainbow City Community for the purpose of finishing the playground constructed by the Community, to buy food for volunteers who are working on the playground, for payment of a light bill and for general cleanup and completion of the playground; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves said request.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the expenditure of \$250 from the General Land Claims Fund for the benefit of the Rainbow City Community for the purpose of finishing the playground area including cleanup, payment of light bills and the purchase of food for volunteers who are working on completing the playground.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of Six for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
