## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Head Start Program received notification of the availability of carry over funds from FY 92-93-94-95-96-97 in the amount of \$151,851; and
- WHEREAS, the carry over funds will enable the Head Start Program to improve services for the 252 children and families that we serve; and
- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council concludes that it would be in the best interest of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to authorizes submission of a grant application for carry over funds in the amount of \$151,851 to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services; and
- WHEREAS, the Matching Requirements of \$37,963, would be met entirely with JOM Program funds provided to the Head Start program through employee time and supplies for the classroom, and by volunteer hours.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves submission of a grant application for carry over funds in the amount of \$151,851, with a Matching Requirement of \$37,963 from JOM funds and volunteer hours, for a total grant application of \$189,814.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 08, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Sections 1 (a), (b), (j), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
