RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested to grant approval to a travel adventure company known as "Anyplace Wild" to film a proposed adventure hike in the Cibecue area; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council approves of the request provided that at least two Tribal Members accompany the film crew and the Anyplace Wild Outfitters Company on the proposed route.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves and grants permission to the Outfitters known as "Anyplace Wild" to travel in the Cibecue area and film a proposed hiking expedition while in the company of Tribal Members so that it can be assured that said route does not violate any cultural or religious protected areas or areas that may be sensitive to the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 8, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>Nine</u> for and <u>Zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (q), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
