RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. Robert Chinche and Mrs. Nellie (Bullock) Chinche is requesting enrollment for their adopted daughter with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed Deborah Lee Chinche's enrollment application whose birth date is May 06, 1988 with supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Enrollment Committee finds Deborah Lee Chinche is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Tribe and possesses the necessary blood quantum of 15/16 White Mountain Apache blood and 15/16 total Indian Blood according to the Tribal Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. and Mrs. Robert Chinche's request for enrollment of their adopted daughter Deborah Lee Chinche's membership into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, and subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202 © and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 18, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article II, Section 1 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
