RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the White River Police Department has requested that the Tribal Council approve a plan for the transfer of tribal prisoners to Apache County jail during the week of the Tribal Fair, August 28 to September 2, 1997; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to create available space to house persons that are arrested during the Tribal Fair and the transfer of prisoners to Apache County jail will eliminate the potential problem of overpopulation; and
- WHEREAS, only high risk prisoners and prisoners that are serving a long term for a major offense are to be considered in the transfer, the daily cost per prisoner is \$38.00, the stay will be very temporary, the Tribe will transport prisoners to and from the facility, medical information on each prisoner will be available but persons in need of medical attention or treatment will not be transported to Apache County jail, and emergency medical service will be provided to the prisoners while in the custody of Apache County but will be paid by the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council having reviewed the proposal and discussed same, agrees that temporary housing of a select number of tribal prisoners in Apache County jail during the Tribal Fair week is necessary to avoid the potential of overpopulation in the jail in the event that persons are arrested during the Tribal Fair week which experience has shown results because of the large crowds and number of visitors to reservation during that week.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the transfer of select tribal prisoners to Apache County jail in accordance with the guidelines set forth in this resolution and those outlined in the Memorandum from Chief of Police Andrew Kane to Ronnie Peaches, Detention Supervisor dated August 14, 1997 and reviewed by the Tribal Council this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 22, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against and <u>one</u> abstention by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a),(b),(i),(k),(s),(t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
