## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Chairman Ronnie Lupe is the official representative to the National Indian Gaming Association [NIGA]; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that an alternate representative should be appointed to NIGA to represent the Tribe's interest and that said person should have an extensive background in casino management; and
- WHEREAS, Mike Unger, the primary management official for the Hon-Dah Casino, is suggested as an alternative representative to NIGA and the Tribal Council agrees.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Primary Management Official Mike Unger of Hon-Dah Casino as the alternate representative to the National Indian Gaming Association.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 22, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a),(i),(s),(t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
