



**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that Mr. and Mrs. Stevie and Linda Kay (Altaha) Goklish have requested enrollment into the White Mountain Apache Tribe for their adopted son McKale Jatón Goklish, whose birth date is February 15, 1992; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed McKale Jatón Goklish's enrollment application with supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds that McKale Jatón Goklish, possesses a blood quantum of $\frac{1}{2}$ White Mountain Apache and $\frac{7}{8}$ total Indian blood; and
- WHEREAS,** the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds that McKale Jatón Goklish, meets the blood quantum requirements set forth in the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and is eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Mr. and Mrs. Stevie and Linda Kay (Altaha) Goklish's request for enrollment of their adopted son, McKale Jatón Goklish for membership in the White Mountain Apache Tribe based on the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, and subject to rescission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202 © and 1-704.

The foregoing resolution was on August 27, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of seven for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
