RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, tribal member, Bernadette Ramon whose birth date is April 30, 1969, and whose is a daughter of Benedict E. Ramon and Ollie June Dunlap, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may become eligible for enrollment in the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and
- WHEREAS, the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Bernadette Ramon, in the presence of a Notary Public on the 3rd day of July. 1997, and are attached hereto.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the tribal relinquishment request of Bernadette Ramon, and her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe is granted relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 27, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>eight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
