RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Gibson and Leonard Smith, brothers and tribal members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, have come before the Tribal Council and requested Council assistance to pay for the burial expenses of their father, Charles Smith, a non-member Native American; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to assist them in the burial expenses as they are tribal members.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes burial expenses in the amount of \$500.00 for each son to help pay for the burial expenses of the late, i.e. father, the Charlie Smith, a non-member Native American.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 27, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1(a),(i),(k),(t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
