RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Virginia Cromwell of Healthy Nations requests financial assistance from the Tribal Council for the purchase of two bicycles at One Hundred Dollars per bicycle for the Fort Sill Oklahoma Bike Run Against Substance Abuse sponsored by the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees to donate Twenty Five Dollars from each Tribal Council Member for the purchase of the two bikes at One Hundred Dollars per bicycle for a total of Two Hundred Dollars, said donation to be paid from Tribal Council Member Travel Accounts.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby agrees to donate Twenty Five Dollars from each Tribal Council Member for the purchase of two bicycles at One Hundred Dollars each for a total of Two Hundred Dollars to be paid from Council Member Travel Accounts so that Tribal youth can participate in the Fort Sill Oklahoma Bike Run Against Substance Abuse.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 10, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section I (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
