## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Member Victor Davis has come before the Tribal Council this date and requests that a bridge to his land near Cibecue ridge be constructed so that he has access to his property; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Davis' homesite is along Cibecue Creek and there is not an adequate access road to his property; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that Harry Brewer from the Public Works Department should visit the site and assess the feasibility of constructing an access road to Victor Davis' land assignment.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs Public Works Director Harry Brewer to visit Victor Davis' land assignment for the purpose of assessing the feasibility of building an access road to Mr. Davis' land assignment.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 10, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
