WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Ramus Albert of the Tribal Land Department has come before the Tribal Council this date to present the Land Board Meeting Minutes and Report for Council review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that this date marks forty years of service by Mr. Albert with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, in appreciation for Mr. Albert's forty years of selfless service to the Tribe, the Tribal Council wishes to provide Mr. Albert a one day fishing vacation at Hurricane Lake; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Albert expresses his gratitude for such recognition.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants Ramus Albert a one day fishing vacation at Hurricane Lake in appreciation for his forty years of selfless service to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (i), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
