RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS,

the Tribal Council, on August 8, 1997, directed the Tribal Council Secretary to post the proposed amendment to the Housing and Construction Code in each district for ten days, as required by the Constitution; and

WHEREAS,

the Council Secretary has advised the Tribal Council that said proposed ordinance has been posted in accordance with that directive; and

WHEREAS,

the Tribal Council has received no opposition to the proposed amended section 7.5 of the Leasehold Mortgage provisions of the Housing and Construction Code to include other lenders, and concludes that Ordinance No. 210 should be enacted into law.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby enacts Ordinance No. 210, amending the White Mountain Apache Tribe Housing and Construction Code.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>September 11, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (e), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
