RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised that individuals identified on the attached enclosure have requested enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee has completely reviewed the enrollment application for each individual, and all supporting documents; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Enrollment Committee finds that the individuals meet the blood quantum requirements set forth in the Constitution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and are eligible for enrollment with the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the enrollment applications for each of the individuals was submitted prior to the 22-H, August 18, 1997 deadline, but was inadvertently omitted from presentation to the Council that following week; and
- WHEREAS, the individuals have not received any Court of Claims judgement funds and thus would be eligible for a per capita distribution of the White Mountain Apache Tribe Docket 22-H funds.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request for membership for the individuals on the attached enclosure into the White Mountain Apache Tribe based upon the recommendation of the Tribal Enrollment Committee, and subject to recission pursuant to the Tribal Enrollment Code, Sections 1-202© and 1-704.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that pursuant to Resolution No 04-96-085 and the Tribe's 22-H Distribution Plan, the above referenced individual shall be eligible to receive a distribution under Court of Claims Case Docket 22-H, because they have not previously received a Court of Claims per capita distribution while enrolled with any other Tribe, and they submitted their enrollment application and all needed documentation by the August 18, 1997, 22-H enrollment deadline.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>October 09, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
