RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has traditionally been a member of the National Congress of American Indians [NCAI]; and
- WHEREAS, payment of membership dues currently due will enable the Tribe to be credentialed as a member in good standing effective November 1997 and to vote at the NCAI annual convention in Santa Fe, New Mexico November 16-21, 1997; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to preserve the White Mountain Apache Tribe's entitlement vote of 180 votes in accordance with NCAI Article IV, Section 3.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes membership renewal in the NCAI and payment of the required dues and subscriptions pursuant to Article III of the NCAI constitution and bylaws.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of Ten for and Zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
