RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised by the Tribal Election Commission that there is a vacancy on the nine member Tribal Election Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council pursuant to Resolution No. 03-97-047, reappointed eight members of the Tribal Election Commission to a new term to expire six months after the 1998 general tribal election but the vacancy on the commission was not filled at that time: and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Election Commission unanimously recommends to the Tribal Council that tribal member Curtis Suttle be appointed by the Tribal Council to fill the vacancy on the Tribal Election Commission and to serve thereon for a term to expire six months after the 1998 general tribal election: and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs with the recommendation of the Tribal Election Commission.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints tribal member Curtis Suttle to the Tribal Election Commission for a term to expire six months after the 1998 general tribal election.

The foregoing resolution was on October 31, 1997, duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe. pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution. including Article IV. Section 1 (a). (s). (t) and (u) and also Article VI. Section 8 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
