RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal member DeJean Rodriquez, former Director of the Chaghache Day Care Center has come before the Tribal Council this date regarding her termination by the Day Care Center Board of Directors; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rodriquez advises the Tribal Council of the many projects and safety concerns that she addressed while she was Director of the Day Care Center, and advises the Council that she protests her termination by the Board of Directors on the basis that it was unfair; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Rodriquez requests that the Tribal Council change her termination status to one of resignation; and
- WHEREAS, based upon her presentation and review of the circumstances giving rise to her termination by the Board of Directors, the Tribal Council concludes that Mrs. Rodriquez's termination status should be changed to one of resignation.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that based on the presentations made before the Tribal Council this date, it hereby directs that DeJean Rodriquez's termination status be changed to one of resignation from her position as Director of the Chaghache Day Care Center.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1997 duly adopted by a vote of eight for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a),(i),(s),(t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
