RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Member Lydia Martin has come before the Tribal Council and requested financial assistance to attend the John Casablancas Modeling and Career Center in Scottsdale, Arizona so that she can be better prepared to pursue employment in the modeling field; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council advises that the limit for assistance is Five Hundred Dollars.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes financial assistance in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars from the appropriate account to assist in the payment of Ms. Martin's tuition fees at the John Casablancas Modeling and Career Center.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 3, 1997</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>ten</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
