tribal member Alana Cassa, with birthdate of August 18, 1980 daughter of Allan Cassa Jr. and Irene (Alsenay) Cassa, has requested that her tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe be relinquished so that she may remain on the rolls with the San Carlos Apache Tribe; and

the necessary documents of relinquishment of headrights were read and signed by Alana Cassa, in the presence of a Notary Public on the 30th day of October, 1997 and are attached hereto.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the request of Mr. & Mrs. Allan and Irene Cassa for their daughter Alana Cassa's relinquishment of tribal membership with the White Mountain Apache Tribe which is relinquished this date.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>December 18, 1997</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>six</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 2 of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
