

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**WHEREAS,** McNary community representatives, Evelyn Mack, Brenda Gloshey, Lorena Hill, and Pamela Carroll have come before the Tribal Council this date with complaints of break ins, random vandalism, gang activity and lack of 24 hour police protection; and


**WHEREAS,** the community representatives request twenty-four hour, eight-hour shift police patrols in the Hondah-McNary area; and

**WHEREAS,** said representatives also advise the council of shooting incidents, of being forced to hire house watchers to protect their homes and request that there be faster follow-up on burglary investigations, that stronger penalties be adopted for gang activities and perhaps a night curfew for youth; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council concludes that these are matters of great concern and that it would be beneficial to schedule a meeting with the Tribal Court, Tribal Police Department, Bureau of Indian Affairs Criminal Investigation Department, Indian Health Services, Law & Order Committee members, Tribal Prosecution and other persons involved in the administration of justice on the reservation.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Council Secretary to notify all the foregoing persons and departments of a mandatory Tribal Council meeting in Tribal Council chambers on Tuesday, February 17, 1998, to commence at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of discussing Police, Tribal Court and administration of justice issues.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (q), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
