RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is concerned about the frequency of motor vehicle accidents in the Salt River Canyon; and
- WHEREAS, it appears to the Tribal Council that there are fatalities every year resulting from vehicle accidents in the Salt River Canyon; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to review the Salt River Canyon accident reports compiled by the Arizona Department of Transportation or Department of Public Safety for the past five (5) years so that it will be able to make recommendations in respect to accident prevention.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby requests the Arizona Department of Transportation to provide the Tribe with a compilation or copies of the Salt River Canyon motor vehicle accident reports for the past five (5) years and to deliver said reports to the Tribal Legal Department.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 12, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
