RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- **WHEREAS**, the Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division of the Tribe is mandated to provide quality recreation on the reservation; and
- WHEREAS, the Division has been unable to provide a quality elk hunt on the west end because of the primitive facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the tribal Budget Committee allocated money for fiscal year 1997-1998 to build a west end elk camp; and
- WHEREAS, the Division has met with the Cibecue Livestock Association, and they have agreed to a site for the elk camp.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby assigns approximately 20 acres in Cibecue Creek, see attached map, to the Wildlife and Outdoor Recreation Division to build and maintain an elk camp.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>February 12, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>cight</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (a), (f), (h), (i), (k), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
