RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Health Advisory Board is the governing body of the tribal health programs of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the health board is currently comprised of seven (7) health board members; and
- WHEREAS, since a vacancy has occurred, the health board has decided to fill that vacancy for the Diamond Creek/North Fork Community; and
- WHEREAS, the health board has formally recommended that Ms. Perlena Baha, a Diamond Creek/North Fork resident, be appointed to represent said community; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Baha's primary responsibilities are to be informed, to make decisions, and to advocate for the Diamond Creek/North Fork Community in health matters.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that after careful review it hereby formally approves Ms. Perlena Baha's appointment to the Tribal Health Advisory Board.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 8, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
