

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, the members of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe are duly elected representatives of their respective districts of the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council have committed its support for the healthy development of Tribal Members; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Tribal Council share a common goal of preventing diabetes and reducing complications of the chronic disease; and


WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has issued an announcement of 5-year non-competitive grants for Special Diabetes Programs for Indians; and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Health Authority is submitting a Year One grant proposal in the amount of \$436,647.00 allocated for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the indirect costs amount has not been identified as a separate amount from direct costs but will be budgeted in accordance with applicable indirect cost guidelines.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the submission of a year One grant proposal to the Department of Health and Human Services for the purposes described herein.

The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (j), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
