RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney advises the Council that the Department of Justice has made available to Tribes in the states of Arizona, Montana, New Mexico and South Dakota the opportunity to file applications for funding for the construction of Juvenile Correction facilities on Tribal lands; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has previously authorized application to HUD for funding to construct a Juvenile Correction facility which was granted in 1997, but which requires a Tribal match of \$800,000 dollars; and
- WHEREAS, the Department of Justice Grant for Juvenile Correction Facilities provides a priority rating for those applications that have already received funding from other private, state, or federal sources and the White Mountain Apache Tribe having received funding from HUD is in a position to file an application with the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for supplemental funding for Juvenile Correctional Facilities and said application should enjoy a priority rating; and
- WHEREAS, because of the tremendous need on the White Mountain Apache Reservation for a Juvenile Correctional Facility, the Tribal Council concludes that direction should be given to the Tribal Planning Department, Grant Writing Division, to submit a timely application to the Department of Justice for a grant for the construction of a Juvenile Correctional Facility; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council will budget operational funding for the facility.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the Tribal Department of Planning to submit a grant application to the Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for a grant under the Juvenile Correctional Facility Grant Program.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that it hereby authorizes the Chairman, and in his absence, the Vice-Chairman to sign any and all necessary authorizations preapplication and application for the Juvenile Correctional Facility grant.
