The foregoing resolution was on April 8, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Constitution, including Article IV, Section 1 (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

# Minutes Land Board Meeting

The regularly scheduled Land Board Meeting for the month of March was held on March 27, 1998, in the Tribal Council Chambers. All Land Board Members were present: Lynn Cody, Lula A. Ivins, Esther T. Lupe, and Rimson Ethelbah. Meeting opened at 9:30 a.m.

- 1. George Pailzote advise the Board Members that he had a land assignment in Diamond Creek between C. Ethelbah, and L. Ethelbah which was approved for him in August 17, 1981, but now there is a trailor there, and request to know whom the homesite was assigned to now. Lula advise McDaniel if there was any land assignment done on this, McDaniel advise the Board Members, that George had relinquished it to a family member, and there was a land dispute on that, a tribal member leasing the homesite to a non-tribal member. Board Members advise George to check into this with McDaniel to recheck into this further. George also advise if his late mothers farmland could be assign to him, Board Members advise for him to check with family members if they will agree with him.
- 2. Hedy Kelewood & Christopher Beatty requesting for homesite in Diamond Creek, homesite that was relinquished back to W.M.A.T. by Anna Goseyun in 1983. Board Members advise McDaniel if its still an open area, McDaniel advise he will check into this, because it was relinquished in 1983 and to this time it might be assigned to someone else. Board Members advise McDaniel to check into this for Hedy. Was put on hold, and will be presented at the next Tribal Council Meeting in April.
- 3. Bernice Quintero request to have survey done on her homesite above Life Savers, also if someone could show her the exact location of her homesite, McDaniel advise Bernice to come into the Land Office on Monday to take Bernice to her homesite.
- 4. Luke & Larson Williams request to relinquished homesite in Diamond Creek to Larson, Relinquishment form and Homesite application were approved.
- 5. Rodecia Harvey requesting for homesite in Whiteriver, Raymus advise I.H.S. has been turning down the homesite for water and sewer. Rodecia advise if there are any openings elsewhere, McDaniel advise there are some areas that is open behind L. Gloshay, McDaniel advise will show her the open areas on Monday.
- 6. Faith B. Johnson leasing a home at Hon-dah homesite and requesting for addition, and to convert the lease to land assignment. McDaniel advise the Board Members that the Tribal Council had told him to do a resurvey on the Hon-dah homesites to 200' X 200', also Keith Jones had told him to hold off on the survey, so he hasn't done any surveying on Hon-dah homesites. Faith advise she had talked with Keith about increasing her homesite, but Keith advise her that McDaniel was to re-survey the Hon-dah homesites. Board Members advise, to have Keith

write a statement regarding this, and will hold on application.

7. Flora white - request to have a renewal on her farmland in E

Flora white - request to have a renewal on her farmland in East Fork, Raymus advise Flora that her farmland application was incomplete, also will check into this.
