RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Tribal Chairman Ronnie Lupe has served many terms as Tribal Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe since 1966; and
- WHEREAS, Chairman Lupe's current term will expire on May 5, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to express its appreciation to Chairman Ronnie Lupe for his years of dedicated service and leadership for the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Chairman Lupe advises the Council that all furniture and furnishing of his office including the Tribal vehicle assigned to him shall remain for his successor except for his personal belongings and he requests that the Council consider granting approval for him to take with him two paintings one of which is of him as a youth when he appeared in the 1947 movie Broken Arrow and the other painting is of his granddaughter's sunrise ceremony; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, and each of them, after having extended their personal thanks and appreciation to Chairman Lupe for his leadership and the lessons and wisdom he has imparted upon members of the Council during his years as Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribe and in consideration therefore, hereby approves Chairman Lupe's request.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves Chairman Ronnie Lupe's request and hereby gives to him as a gift from the Tribal Council, two acrylic paintings one of which is of him as a youth in the 1947 movie Broken Arrow and the other of his granddaughter's sunrise ceremony.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 9, 1998</u> duly adopted by a vote of <u>nine</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (i), (k), (s), (t), and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
