RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 7, 1998, Michael Johnson, a long time resident of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation passed away; and
- **WHEREAS,** Mr. Johnson, although not a member of this Tribe, worked for Fort Apache Timber Company for 18 years.
- WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson's children are enrolled members of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, it is the request of the family that Mr. Johnson's body be buried at the Whiteriver Cemetery; and
- WHEREAS, because of the extensive and long-term relationship Mr. Johnson had with the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Council wishes to honor this final request for Michael Johnson.
- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby grants the family's request for burial of the body of Mr. Michael Johnson at the Whiteriver Cemetery.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>April 13, 1998</u>, duly adopted by a vote of <u>seven</u> for and <u>zero</u> against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (h), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
