- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.9 of the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, the Tribal Council has the responsibility of appointing Tribal Court Judges based upon nominations; and
- WHEREAS, tribal members Marjorie Grimes, Faye Cody, and Durango Fall have been nominated for the judiciary and meet all the qualifications set forth in the Judicial Code to serve as a Tribal Court Judge; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concurs that the nominated individuals have the wisdom and compassion to effectively serve as Tribal Court Judges and should be appointed as follows:

Associate Judge

Juvenile Judge

- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Marjorie Grimes Chief Judge of the Tribal Court, Fave Cody as Associate Judge, and Durango Fall, as Juvenile Judge.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tribal Council that the foregoing appointees shall each serve a regular four year term pursuant to Section 2.9 of the Judicial Code of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1998, 1998, duly adopted by a vote of nine for and one against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (q), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
