

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council wishes to assure that locally produced or purchased construction materials are used in any construction work within the Reservation; and

WHEREAS, at present, a considerable amount of materials from outside vendors are brought on to the Reservation for road work and building construction; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council concludes that if a Tribal enterprise or other Reservation based business can be competitive with off-Reservation vendors in terms of pricing and quality the enterprise or businesses should be given the opportunity to be the supplier of such materials on any road construction or building construction project within the Reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes as policy for the Tribe that Tribal enterprises and other Reservation based businesses be given the opportunity to meet any bid from outside vendors for materials needed in building and road work repair and construction, provided that the quality of the materials is comparable and that the Tribal enterprise or other Reservation based vendor can meet the contractor's supply schedule and specifications.

The foregoing resolution was on May 15, 1998 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article IV, Section 1 (a), (b), (h), (i), (s), (t) and (u) of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe September 30, 1993, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on November 12, 1993, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
